Subsequently, with reference to the abovementioned point 2 (b), working alongside the UNCRC principles of children's Right to Participation the Commission plans to involve more children in this program intrinsically, therefore, audio-video messages of about 30 Seconds to 1 Minute are invited from the children/students of classes 9th to 12th with full perental consent and with complete regard to child safety virtual (online/cyber related) as well as real. In the message, children can talk about their experiences, pointers, patterns, go-to routine; for relaxation etc. which help them cope with exam stress/anxiety and ace their examinations.
