

The appointment of JBTs will be made purely on the basis of existing R&P Rules read with the NCTE norms and guidelines issued from time to time (Govt. instructions vide letter No. EDN-C-A(3)-1/2016-Vol-I dated 27.09.2023).

	(b) Desirable Qualification	Knowledge of customs, manners and dialects of Himachal Pradesh and suitability for appointment in the peculiar conditions prevailing in the Pradesh.
2.	Pay Scale	The Junior Basic Trained Teacher appointed on contract basis will be paid consolidated fixed contractual amount @ Rs. 17820/- /- P.M. (which shall be equal to 60% of the Level 8 Cell I @ Rs.29700/-). Annual increase in contractual emoluments for the subsequent year(s) will be allowed if contract is extended beyond one year.
3.	Age Criteria	<p>Between 18 to 45 years.</p> <p>In case of Direct recruitment through batch wise basis, candidates who have crossed the upper age limit of 45 years shall also be considered for appointment in case they have registered their names before attaining the age of 45 years in employment exchange of H.P.</p>
4.	Any other information.	<p>(i) For batch wise recruitment the batch will be reckoned from the date of issuance of JBT/D.El.Ed. pass certificate.</p> <p>If more than one candidate has been issued the JBT/El.Ed. pass certificate on the same date than the inter-se-seniority would be determined on the basis of TET (JBT) merit and in the event of TET merit being same senior in age would get precedence over junior in age.</p> <p>(ii) Those who are not willing to serve in the schools in interior and tribal areas of Himachal Pradesh need not come for counseling.</p> <p>(iii) The candidates will have to bring with them only the relevant degree/diploma in original with self attested copies thereof for the post and also latest certificates regarding their claim for consideration under any of the reserve categories of H.P.</p> <p>(iv) In case an Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidate is not available for selection, the post will be treated automatically as de-reserved and will be filled up from a non EWS candidate of unreserved category.</p>
